#### YSP STIPEND APPLICATION FOR ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED STUDENTS

The Young Scholars Program is funded by Florida State University. With this support, we are pleased to be able to offer positions for the 2012 program, covering fully the costs of room, board, and academic tuition for <u>each</u> participant.
